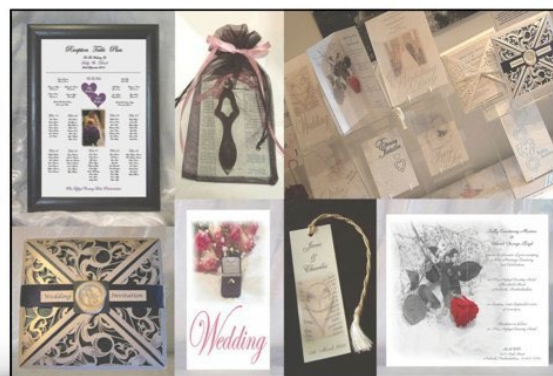


Invitations and Beyond

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Your Wedding Stationery plays such an important part in creating the perfect first impression and setting the tone for your special day, so it's very important to make the right choices. Co-ordinating your invitations with other stationery pieces is just the way to achieve this. Wedding stationery nowadays encompasses much more than just Wedding Invitations and below is a guide to the different elements so that you can make an informed choice as to what you might need.

After the wedding: You will want to send out *Thank You Cards* to all your guests. Separate *Change of Address Cards* can be sent if you have changed your residence, however this information can be included in the *Thank You Cards*.

Co-ordinating your wedding stationery can set the wedding theme from the outset. Sally Lloyd explains how to get it right every time!

Before the wedding: *Save The Date Cards* can be sent to advise your guests of your date in advance and is helpful if guests need to make travel arrangements, or if your wedding will be during any of the main holidays.

Other than wedding invitations, you may require invitations to your engagement party and hen/stag parties. Your *Wedding Invitations* and *Evening Invitations* should be sent out 8-12 weeks before the wedding and inserts can include a *Reply Card*, a *Direction Card* with directions to the ceremony and reception venues and can also include a map, an *Accommodation Card* with details of local hotels/B&B's and an *Information Card* showing any other details about your wedding that guests need to know.

For the ceremony: An *Order of Service* is provided to guests at a church wedding and an *Order of Ceremony* for a non-religious ceremony. A *Wedding Program* informing guests of the events of the day can also be incorporated into the *Order of Service/Ceremony* or it can be a separate item that can be provided to guests as they arrive at the reception venue.

For the reception: You may require items such as *Place Cards* or *Escort Cards*, *Table Numbers* or *Names*, *Menus*, and a *Table Plan*. Other items that you may have for the reception are a *Guest Book*, *Tags* for items such as *Favours* and *Wedding Wish Trees*, and *Signage*

pieces according to your chosen design, colours, and theme, and will always be available to advise you from the design stage right through to your wedding day.
